



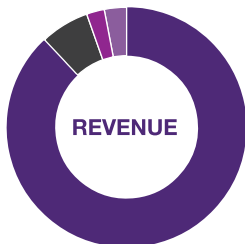
# TRINITY CHRISTIAN SCHOOL'S *Guide to Giving*

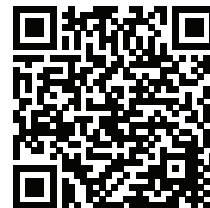
## ACADEMIC & ATHLETIC GIVING OPPORTUNITIES
